Dear ServingHIM Family,

We are indeed grateful for twenty-five years on mission with our Lord and Savior. We come together as a family of believers in adoration and praise, following God's vision for our future. We partner with churches in Romania, Guatemala, and Moldova sharing Jesus Christ with as many people as possible.

Our medical team follows in the footsteps of the Great Physician, providing patient care as hurting people walk through the darkest times of their lives. Each of our medical facilities are ministries of the local church, debt free and operate full-time. In conjunction with our medical staff, we send specialized teams to provide access to medical care that otherwise would not be available. Serving HIM mission volunteers have the opportunity to pray and share the Gospel with men, women, and children, ministering to their spiritual needs as they work to treat their physical needs. Our mission is to make disciples through Jesus Christ, bringing hope and healing worldwide.

Russia launched an unprecedented assault on Ukraine, causing Europe's largest refugee crisis since World War II. These horrific acts of destruction and loss of life caused devastation and heartbreak to Ukrainian families. Serving HIM moved quickly to come to their aid in this humanitarian crisis. Because we have medical clinics within minutes of the southern borders of Ukraine in Romania and Moldova, we were able to provide much needed resources to our partnering churches to meet refugee families at the border. We provided food, shelter, a pillow under their heads and a warm bed as well as resources to help them relocate to cities in Western Europe. We connected them with a network of churches along the way, bringing a loving embrace of Jesus Christ on their path. Many heard the Gospel and received the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Most recently we initiated the construction of a new hospital (out-patient surgical center) in conjunction with our Diaconia Medical Center in Romania. Russia has damaged or destroyed over four hundred medical facilities and hospitals in Ukraine and the Diaconia Christian Hospital will bring much needed medical care to this region of the world. We are helping train the next generation, using medical expertise and advancing medical knowledge in areas of great need.


Serving**HIM** continues to support our village church plants, providing resources to our missionary pastors as well as helping orphans, widows and hurting people –"the least of these."



INTENTIONAL DISCIPLESHIP





Since our inception, the desire of Serving**HIM** has been the application of God's Great Commission in our ministry and our personal lives. Our mission is to make disciples through Jesus Christ, bringing hope and healing worldwide. Over many years our foundational approach to making disciples of Jesus Christ has been engaging men, women, and children with God's Word and the love of our Lord.

Activities and programs involve living out our faith with care, compassion, and joy, following the teachings and model of Jesus. We call this "Intentional Discipleship."

Jesus is the Cornerstone of Serving**HIM** and **Intentional Discipleship** is at the forefront of our ministry.





HOME TO HOME EVANGELISM - In partnership with local pastors and missionaries, Serving**HIM** missionaries visit village families in their homes to share the Gospel. Many villagers have never met Americans before and are often honored to host American missionaries. This gives our teams the opportunities to share the Gospel around a meal or refreshment while connecting with local families on their "turf" and within their culture.

ANIMAL MINISTRY - Working in conjunction with local farmers, Serving**HIM** missionaries deliver goats (pigs and chickens in Guatemala) to families in need who are being ministered to by the local church. This is yet another opportunity to provide physical support while sharing faith as well.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY - Serving**HIM** missionary teams present half-day VBS programs in high profile areas of a village. This often attracts a crowd of children and families who might otherwise have no connection to the local church. In addition, Serving**HIM** teams visit local public elementary schools to teach on matters of general and dental hygiene, as well as to share the Gospel.

MEDICAL/DENTAL - Serving**HIM** maintains a small fleet of mobile medical/dental units in different parts of the world. This enables our medical and dental professionals to provide mobile examinations where appropriate.


FOOD BASKETS/BIBLES - Serving**HIM** teams as well as partner church missionaries deliver bags of non-perishable food to families in need, along with a Bible in their native language.

CONFERENCES - Serving**HIM** hosts regional Pastor's conferences, as well as men's and women's conferences to train, disciple, and encourage people to grow in their walk with the Lord and to disciple others.



Serving**HIM** responded quickly with our church partners in Romania and Moldova to provide humanitarian aid when Russia launched an unprecedented assault on Ukraine. With bombs and rockets of destruction falling all around them, hurting and broken families were fleeing their homes and country. They desperately needed resources like food, shelter, a soft pillow, and the warm embrace of Jesus Christ. Many came to the saving grace of Jesus during this horrific event.

GROUNDBREAKING: DIACONIA CHRISTIAN HOSPITAL



In 1998, Serving**HIM** came alongside a small two-room medical clinic in Brăila, Romania. The Diaconia Clinic is now a 40,000 sq. ft. multi-specialty clinic, staffed by 30 full and part-time Romanian physicians, dentists, and 20 support staff. The Diaconia team has treated over 40,000 patients in the past year, as well as a number of Ukrainian refugees fleeing their war-torn homeland.

The need to provide surgical services at Diaconia Clinic has grown over the past several years, but came into clear focus in the past six months. The clinic serves a population of 220,000 people with a draw area of over 1 million in South-Eastern Romania. The need for surgical capabilities has been accentuated by the loss of over 400 medical facilities in neighboring Ukraine.

The Diaconia Christian Hospital will offer two operatory suites, and an endoscopy suite, as well as post-operative stay capabilities.

Existing laboratory and pharmacy services will be expanded. Imaging services will also be offered.

Serving HIM anticipates sending surgical specialty teams to augment the surgical staff at Diaconia in the years ahead. Surgical interventions such as hysterectomies, hernia repairs, and cleft lip/palate procedures will provide a needed level of care to the community and surrounding region.

Proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ is at the core of our mission. Each patient encounter is an opportunity to provide hope and healing in the name

of our Savior.
